### THE CHALLENGE

The Poole College of Management, like other top professional schools, is adapting to a changing environment with students increasingly relying on distance learning and review of recorded content. PCOM challenged the design team to create a showplace classroom with advanced video technology capable of hosting multi-camera recordings, live distance learning events, and web conferences—all in a sleek, sophisticated architectural environment with seamless integration of the technology into the room. The goal was to create a system that would be simple and familiar and intuitive for faculty who teach daily classes, but capable of creating the highest level of recorded content when needed.

#### **OUR SOLUTION**

In close collaboration with the architect, KONTEK integrated the visible technology components into the classroom's walls, ceiling and furniture in ways that were elegant and unobtrusive, including a custom-designed instructor's lectern. Wireless presentation technology and automatic camera and microphone systems allow the instructor to leave the lectern area and freely roam the room. With an intuitive touch panel interface, the AV system is simple for the teaching faculty to operate. When needed, a technician may take over from the adjacent control room and produce high quality recordings or originate live streaming events.
